

## Important Notes on Application for the Tourist Guide Pass

A tourist guide is the person assigned by a travel agent to receive and take care of travellers visiting Hong Kong. With a view to improving tourist guides' service quality, the TIC set up a **Tourist Guide Accreditation System** on 1 July 2004, under which all tourist guides assigned by member agents to receive visitors to Hong Kong are required to have a valid **Tourist Guide Pass** issued by the TIC.

### (I) Application requirements for the Tourist Guide Pass <sup>(Note 1)</sup>

1. 18 years old or above;
2. Holders of the Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card, or holders of the Hong Kong Identity Card who are not subject to any condition of stay;
3. Secondary school graduates <sup>(Note 2)</sup> or above;
4. Holding certificates recognised by the TIC and passing the relevant examinations (Please refer to Item VII of Pages 4 - 5);
5. Holders of a valid first aid certificate or attendance certificate issued by one of the following six institutions: the Hong Kong Red Cross, Hong Kong St. John Ambulance, the Auxiliary Medical Service, The Hong Kong Life Saving Society, the Hong Kong Police Force and the Hong Kong Fire Services Department; or having completed a training course in first aid and holding a valid certificate to that effect issued by an organisation approved by the Commissioner for Labour <sup>(Note 3)</sup>; or having attended the TIC's first aid talk (In-service medical professionals or those having retired for not more than two years may apply for exemption but relevant supporting documents must be presented);
6. Signing of a declaration stating that the applicant is physically and mentally fit to be a tourist guide, and that there is no other reason that will cause the TIC to consider him/her not fit and proper to be a tourist guide; and
7. Declaration of any criminal conviction in Hong Kong or elsewhere in accordance with the Declaration Form provided by the TIC.

#### Note 1:

In any of the following situations, a Tourist Guide Pass application will be deemed to be in need of special deliberation and will be referred to the Tourist Guide and Tour Escort Deliberation Committee for deliberation:

1. the applicant provides factually untrue information or is suspected of making any false statement;
2. the applicant declares that he/she has been convicted of a criminal offence the applicant declares that he/she has been convicted in Hong Kong or elsewhere of an offence which involved narcotics or drugs, sex or violence, or seriously improper conduct or dishonesty (including but not in any way limited to: unlawfully undertaking any business without proper authorisation or permission; smuggling; theft; forgery; fraud; deceit; burglary; handling stolen goods, bribery or corruption);
3. the applicant fails to declare that he/she has been convicted in Hong Kong or elsewhere of an offence listed above;
4. the applicant's Tourist Guide Pass or Tour Escort Pass has been revoked, or the applicant's application for Pass renewal has been rejected;
5. the applicant's Tourist Guide Pass or Tour Escort Pass has been revoked and he/she has failed to return the Pass to the TIC within the required time limit of seven days;
6. the applicant has worked as a tourist guide without a Tourist Guide Pass or with an invalid Tourist Guide Pass; or the applicant has worked as a tour escort without a Tour Escort Pass or with an invalid Tour Escort Pass; or
7. the applicant has violated the Code of Conduct for Tourist Guides or other TIC rules while holding an invalid Tourist Guide Pass and the **Tourist Guide and Tour Escort Deliberation Committee / Compliance Committee** has imposed a penalty; or the applicant has violated the Code of Conduct for Outbound Tour Escorts or other TIC rules while holding an invalid Tour Escort Pass and the **Compliance Committee** has imposed a penalty.

#### Note 2:

Definition of 'secondary school graduates':

- ▶ Completion of Form 5 or Year 11 under the old secondary education system (5-2-3 education system) of Hong Kong or the British-style education system; or
- ▶ Completion of Senior Secondary 3 or the 12th Grade under the new secondary education system (3-3-4 education system) of Hong Kong or the US-style education system.

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## (II) How to apply

1. Return the completed "Application Form for the Tourist Guide Pass" and "Declaration" (Attachment I) together with the following documents to the TIC executive office by post or in person:
  - i. A photocopy\* of the result slip of the TIC Tourist Guide Accreditation System Examination OR recognised certificate;
  - ii. A photocopy\* of academic proof;
  - iii. Photocopy\* of first aid certificate or attendance certificate issued by institutions recognised by the TIC;
  - iv. One 1.5" x 2" recent colour photo on white background with the applicant's name written on the back; and
  - v. Application fee that can be paid in the ways as follows:
    - a. A crossed cheque amounting to **HK\$300** payable to "Travel Industry Council of Hong Kong";
    - b. Photocopy of bank-in slip (**Please deposit cash only**) / transaction record \*\* and
    - c. Cash for submission of application in person only.

Please do NOT mail cash.

2. Acknowledgement of receipt will be sent by SMS or e-mail upon the receipt of an application submitted by post. For applicants who do not receive any message of acknowledgement within 7 working days since the date of posting, please contact the TIC Industry Training Department on 2807-1199.
3. Eligible applicants will be issued the Pass **within 4 to 5 weeks** from the date of submission of application. Pass holders will be notified by **SMS or e-mail** when the Pass is ready for collection. Applicants who do not receive any notification for the collection of Pass in due course may contact the TIC Industry Training Department on 2807-1199.
4. Those in urgent need may request an '**Acknowledgement of Application for the Tourist Guide Pass**', a document that provisionally allows its holder to undertake the duties of a tourist guide, and **the application must be submitted by the eligible applicants or their authorised representatives in person**, together with the original and photocopy of the supporting documents and the application fee.

\* Laminated documents are NOT accepted. Applicants should bring the **original** of the supporting documents required if they submit their application in person. All the original documents will be returned to the applicants immediately after checking of information. For applications by post, the applicants must present the **original** of the supporting documents for information checking when they collect their Tourist Guide or the '**Acknowledgement of Application for the Tourist Guide Pass**'. If it is found that the applicant has submitted any false information, the TIC may revoke the Pass or letter of acknowledgement issued at any time and the case shall be reported to the police.

Please write the applicant's full name on the back of the copy of bank-in slip / transaction record and submit it together with the application form. Applicants who submit application by post are advised to **keep the original bank-in slip for record** in order to avoid the loss of payment evidence caused by delivery error.

## (III) Application fee

Application fee is stated on page 1 of Application Form for the Tourist Guide Pass.

## (IV) Time limit for application

1. The time limit for first-time applications for the Pass is **two years**. People who have obtained certificates recognised by the TIC and passed the relevant examinations must apply for the Pass **within two years after being issued with the certificate or notified of their passing the examinations (whichever is later)**.
2. If qualified applicants apply for the Pass after the application deadline, they will have to **pass the designated written examination and road test** before submitting their application.

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#### **(V) Restrictions on Tourist Guide Pass**

1. General Tourist Guide Pass: it is for applicants holding certificates of categories I to VI. The Pass holders are allowed to use any language to receive inbound package tours. The Pass is valid is for 3 years and has to be renewed every 3 years.
2. Tourist Guide Pass for English-speaking tourist guides: it is for applicants obtaining the Pass through the **Waiver Programme for English-speaking Tourist Guides** (which ended on 28 February 2010). The Pass is valid is for 3 years and has to be renewed every 3 years. The Pass holders are not allowed to use Cantonese or Mandarin to receive inbound package tours.
3. Tourist Guide Pass for non-English-and-Chinese-speaking tourist guides: it is for applicants obtaining the Pass through the **Waiver Programme for Non-English-and-Chinese-speaking Tourist Guides (Waiver Programme)** (which ended on 28 Feb 2010) or the **Accreditation System for Non-English-and-Chinese-speaking Tourist Guides (Accreditation System)**. The Pass holders are not allowed to use Cantonese, English or Mandarin to receive inbound package tours. The Pass issued under the **Waiver Programme** is valid for 3 years and the renewed Pass is valid for 1 year while the Pass issued under the **Accreditation System** is valid for 1 year and has to be renewed annually.
4. Holders of general Tourist Guide Pass and Tourist Guide Pass for English-speaking tourist guides must fulfil the requirements of the **Continuing Professional Development Scheme for Tourist Guides (CPD Scheme)** in the designated period before applying for renewal of the Pass.
5. Holders of Tourist Guide Pass for non-English-and-Chinese-speaking tourist guides are temporarily exempted from the **CPD Scheme**. However, proof of being employed by a TIC member travel agent must be produced when applying for the renewal of the Pass.

**(VIII) Notes on collection of personal data**

1. The personal data provided in this application form will be used by the Travel Industry Council of Hong Kong (TIC) for the following purposes:
  - (i) to process applications for the Tourist Guide Pass;

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- (ii) to maintain applicants' records in the TIC;
  - (iii) to issue the Tourist Guide Pass to qualified applicants;
  - (iv) to include the names (Chinese and English) of Pass holders, their Pass numbers and the expiry dates of their Passes in the Tourist Guide Directory, which is displayed on the TIC's website and may be accessed by travel agents and members of the public;
  - (v) to post on the TIC's website the information on suspensions or revocations of Tourist Guide Passes, which may be accessed by travel agents and members of the public;
  - (vi) to disseminate information of the TIC (including course information) to Pass holders by any means (including SMS, e-mail, fax, post, etc.); and
  - (vii) any other related purposes.
2. Applicants are advised to provide sufficient information as far as possible, otherwise their applications may be unable to be processed.
  3. Applicants will be required to produce their HKID Card in person for verification purposes, and staff of the TIC will only sign the application form after verifying the contents of the applicant's HKID Card. If an applicant is unable to come to the TIC in person, the applicant may submit a copy of his/her HKID Card by post or by fax but any such copy shall be retained until such time as the applicant concerned is able to produce his/her HKID Card in person for verification purposes. The TIC reserves the right to require the production and to make and retain copies of an applicant's HKID Card in any circumstances which are permitted by law.
  4. The TIC will keep the personal data of applicants confidential but may provide such data to any other person or his/her representative for any one or more of the purposes set out in paragraph 1 above.
  5. According to the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, applicants have the right to:
    - (i) ascertain whether their personal data are held by the TIC;
    - (ii) obtain a copy of the data mentioned in paragraph 5(i); and
    - (iii) correct their personal data held by the TIC.
- Applicants should provide the TIC with sufficient information in order for their identity to be determined, otherwise their data access request may be rejected. The TIC may impose a fee on any such request.
6. Any request for access to personal data should be made in writing and addressed to the TIC Industry Training Department at Rooms 1706-09, Fortress Tower, 250 King's Road, North Point, Hong Kong.

## Points to note for holders of the Tourist Guide Pass

### I. Conditions for issuance of the Tourist Guide Pass

1. The Tourist Guide Pass is issued by the Travel Industry Council of Hong Kong (TIC) and subject to the relevant regulations of the TIC as currently in force and as amended from time to time. Pass holders are required to read about the latest news at the TIC's website regularly.
2. The Tourist Guide Pass is the property of the TIC. It is not transferable and must not be used for purposes other than those specified. The TIC reserves the right to revoke, terminate or withdraw the Pass.
3. Holders of the Tourist Guide Pass must wear the valid Pass on their chest while on duty, and must cooperate with the inspectors assigned by the TIC by producing the Tourist Guide Pass and Hong Kong Identity Card for identity verification upon request.
4. The names (Chinese and English) of Pass holders, their Pass numbers and the expiry dates of their Passes will be included in the Tourist Guide Directory, which is displayed on the TIC's website and may be accessed by travel agents and members of the public.
5. Pass holders must observe the codes and directives concerning tourist guides issued by the TIC. Non-compliance with the codes and directives will be subject to disciplinary procedures. Information on suspensions or revocations of Tourist Guide Passes will be posted on the TIC's website for different durations in accordance with relevant guidelines, which may be accessed by travel agents and members of the public.
6. Loss of the Tourist Guide Pass should be reported to the TIC immediately for re-issuance of a new one. The procedures and application form for re-issuing the Tourist guide Pass can be downloaded from the TIC's website ([https://www.tichk.org/sites/default/files/2021-02/guide\\_pass\\_reissue.pdf](https://www.tichk.org/sites/default/files/2021-02/guide_pass_reissue.pdf)).
7. Pass holders are obligated to take steps by themselves to ensure that they do not contravene the laws of Hong Kong or other places when working as a tour guide. Pass holders must also take initiative to inform the TIC at their earliest convenience should they be convicted an offence which involved narcotics or drugs, sex or violence, or seriously improper conduct or dishonesty (including but not in any way limited to: unlawfully undertaking any business without proper authorisation or permission; smuggling; theft; forgery; fraud; deceit; burglary; handling stolen goods, bribery or corruption) at any place and any time. Otherwise, their Pass may be suspended or revoked.
8. Pass holders whose Pass is issued through the "Waiver Programme for Non-English-and-Chinese-Speaking Tourist Guides" or under the "Accreditation System for Non-English-and-Chinese-Speaking Tourist Guides" are not allowed to use Cantonese, English or Mandarin in receiving inbound package tours.
9. Pass holders whose Pass is issued through "Waiver Programme for English-Speaking Tourist Guides" (formerly known as "Waiver Programme for English-but-non-Chinese-Speaking Tourist Guides") are not allowed to use Cantonese or Mandarin in receiving inbound package tours.

## II. Renewal of the Tourist Guide Pass

1. Pass holders who wish to continue to undertake their duties as a tourist guide must **observe the expiry date of the Pass** and renew their Pass accordingly. **No reminders** will be sent by the TIC for the renewal of the Pass in due course. Application for renewal of the Pass will be accepted **three months before its expiry date**.

The information and application form for the renewal of the Tourist Guide Pass can be downloaded from the TIC's website ([https://www.tichk.org/sites/default/files/2021-02/guide\\_pass\\_renewal\\_eng.pdf](https://www.tichk.org/sites/default/files/2021-02/guide_pass_renewal_eng.pdf)).

2. Pass holders are required to complete the Continuing Professional Development Scheme for Tourist Guides (CPD Scheme) in the designated period before applying for the Pass. Pass holders whose Pass is issued through the "Waiver Programme for Non-English-and-Chinese-Speaking Tourist Guides" or under the "Accreditation System for Non-English-and-Chinese-Speaking Tourist Guides" are temporarily exempted from the CPD Scheme until further announcements.
3. If Pass holders renew their Pass **more than two years** after the expiry date, they **must pass an examination to be designated by the TIC**. Candidates who fail the examination may re-sit, and the number of re-sits allowed is not limited.
4. The **old Pass must be returned** to the TIC when collecting the renewed Pass.
5. In any of the following situations, a Tourist Guide Pass renewal application will be deemed to be in need of special deliberation and will be referred to the Tourist Guide and Tour Escort Deliberation Committee for deliberation:
  - (a) the applicant provides factually untrue information or is suspected of making any false statement;
  - (b) the applicant declares that he/she has been convicted in Hong Kong or elsewhere of an offence which involved narcotics or drugs, sex or violence, or seriously improper conduct or dishonesty (including but not in any way limited to: unlawfully undertaking any business without proper authorisation or permission; smuggling; theft; forgery; fraud; deceit; burglary; handling stolen goods, bribery or corruption);
  - (c) the applicant fails to declare that he/she has been convicted in Hong Kong or elsewhere of an offence listed above;
  - (d) the applicant's Tourist Guide Pass or Tour Escort Pass has been revoked, or the applicant's application for Pass renewal has been rejected;
  - (e) the applicant's Tourist Guide Pass or Tour Escort Pass has been revoked and he/she has failed to return the Pass to the TIC within the required time limit of seven days;
  - (f) the applicant has worked as a tourist guide without a Tourist Guide Pass or with an invalid Tourist Guide Pass; or the applicant has worked as a tour escort without a Tour Escort Pass or with an invalid Tour Escort Pass; or
  - (g) the applicant has violated the Code of Conduct for Tourist Guides or other TIC rules while holding an invalid Tourist Guide Pass and the Tourist Guide and Tour Escort Deliberation Committee / Compliance Committee has imposed a penalty; or the applicant has violated the Code of Conduct for Outbound Tour Escorts or other TIC rules while holding an invalid Tour Escort Pass and the



Compliance Committee has imposed a penalty.

### III. Change of contact information

The TIC will disseminate its information (including course information) to tourist guides from time to time by SMS, e-mail, fax or post.

In order to ensure effective transmission of information, tourist guides should notify the TIC of any changes in the contact information by downloading the form "Application for Change of Contact Information" from the TIC's website ([https://www.tichk.org/sites/default/files/2021-02/change\\_contact\\_info\\_all.pdf](https://www.tichk.org/sites/default/files/2021-02/change_contact_info_all.pdf)), and completing and returning it to the TIC Industry Training Department.
