

(HONG KONG, 13 August, 2019, 1200hrs) – Airport Authority Hong Kong (AA) has been working with airlines on rescheduling flights from 0600hrs today, during which the number of flight movements has been affected.

In view of the reduced flight movements after rescheduling, as well as the need to maintain effective airport operation and crowd management, the frequency of Airport Express Line service will be adjusted from 1300hrs. Meanwhile, all the public car park spaces in Car Park 1 and 4 are already full. The AA urges passengers to use public transportation and allow sufficient time to go to the airport.

Passengers are reminded to pay attention to the latest flight information through the airport's website and the "HKG My Flight" mobile app, and confirm their flights before heading to the airport. Passengers can also check with their airlines for the latest flight information.

The Airport Emergency Centre has been activated by the AA. The AA has noticed that there are calls online for public assembly in the airport this afternoon. The AA will work closely with its business partners with a view to gradually resuming normal airport operations as soon as possible.
